

# 1. EQUIPMENT

- a. Bats must have an official USA logo sticker on them for use in a game
- b. Helmets must be worn by all batters and baserunners

## ROSTERS/PLAYING TIME

- a. Players cannot sit out more than two consecutive innings
- b. Nine players on the field for the defensive team
- c. Continuous roster batting order with everyone batting in the lineup

#### 3. OFFICIAL GAME TIME/SCORING

- a. Six inning Games.
- b. Umpire announces the official starting time and sets the timer
- c. No new inning may start after 75 minutes unless otherwise scheduled/announced.
- d. New Inning starts immediately after the third out.
- e. "Drop dead" time is 5 minutes before the next game time (score reverts to previous inning)
- f. Five run limit completes the half-inning for the first three innings
- g. The game is complete if a team is winning by 10 runs after four innings

## 4. DUGOUTS

a. The home team will take the third base dugout

## 5. WARMUPS

a. Warmups will be completed in the outfield or outside of the field prior to the games start.

# 6. PRE-GAME

a. A meeting between head coaches and the umpire will happen 5 minutes before game time.

#### 7. UMPIRES

- a. Three outs per inning: Four balls, three strikes in an expanded strike zone (shoulders to mid-shin)
- b. The head coach is the only coach allowed to discuss calls with the umpires.
- c. Umpires will encourage quick transitions between half innings

#### 8. BATTING

a. No on-deck batters allowed

## 9. BASERUNNING

- a. Runners may leave the base when the ball crosses the area of the plate
- b. Runners may advance when there is a pitch that goes behind the catcher (passed ball)
- c. Runners may steal once per half inning, with any number of runners on base.
- d. Runners may not steal home.



- 10. PITCHING 3 innings per pitcher National Pitching Rules Apply
  - a. Pitchers are allowed eight pitches at the start of their pitching time on the mound
  - b. 5 warm up pitches or 60 seconds between innings (whichever comes first).
  - c. Coach may warm-up pitchers (while catcher puts on gear)
- 11. MISCELLANEOUS
  - a. DROPPED 3RD STRIKE Batter is out on a dropped 3rd strike
  - b. INFIELD FLY There is no infield fly rule
  - 12. When not found in these rules, please consult the Little League International Rules. When in conflict, local rules prevail.
